



Product Description

Pelvic instability belt with 'many tailed' pattern allows variable tension on each set of straps, with strong tension over pubic area and lighter tension under the abdomen. Washing instructions include slina.

Usage Information (See diagram)

- 1. Open the belt out and place it on the lower back. The wide portion of the belt (label inside and at the top) should fit snugly into the hollow of the back.
- 2. Anchor the belt temporarily by drawing the top tails around the upper abdomen and fastening together loosely.
- 3. Bring the lowest tails downwards and forwards under the lower abdomen across the pubic bone, tightening as much as necessary to give support without pressing unduly on the symphysis pubis. Fasten together.
- 4. Bring the middle tails around in the same way fastening together just above and slightly overlapping the lowest pair.
- 5. Adjust the top tails again in a downward and forwards direction to slightly overlap the middle pair. Do not wear the top tails at breastbone level.
- 6. This illustrates the final position of all tails overlapping to give full support to the pelvis.

Indications for Use

The brace is designed for expectant mothers. Allows variable tension on each set of straps, with strong tension over the pubic area and lighter tension under the abdomen. Adaptable to a standing or sitting position and can be worn over clothing. Provides strong circumferential support around the pelvis holding the two sacroiliac joints and the symphysis pubis joint firmly. It is recommended that individuals seek guidance from a medical practitioner regarding the most appropriate brace and wearing schedule.

Contraindications

- Unsuitable for prolonged use.
- Care is required to ensure that the garment is not constrictive. Any known allergy and/ or hypersensitivity to any materials
- listed in the product composition.
- Perform regular skin and circulation checks

Warnings and Precautions

- We recommend the initial fitting of this device be conducted by a suitably qualified healthcare professional who will advise the period of use.
- · Carefully read all instructions and warnings prior to use. · Follow all instructions to ensure proper performance of the

- should always be fastened when the device is not being worn or when being washed.

Washing and Care Instructions

- 1. Close over all hook/loop straps.
- 2. Hand wash in cool water using mild detergent.
- 3. Rinse and dry flat.
- 4. Do not spin or tumble dry.
- 5. Do not use fabric conditioner at any time. 6. Check for any degradation that may affect use.
- 7. Periodically check hook/loop fasteners are operating securely.

Nylon, Polyester, Elastane, Cotton

Storage and Transport Conditions

Store in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight, in the original packaging.
